

"Thank You, Vibrant Broadband Subscribers!"

e would like to start off by saying "Thank You" to our VIBRANT Broadband subscribers. You put your trust in us and are helping build a local Internet service we can all be proud of.

In 2015, Meeker Cooperative was looking into Smart Grid technology to connect its substations with fiber for the purpose of electrical data collection. At the same time, Meeker Cooperative Members were asking about getting better Internet service to their homes.

Rural Internet had been expensive, slow, and inconsistent. It was typically delivered through aging copper wire with its very limited data and speeds, high-latency satellite signals, or early wireless transceivers. For decades the Internet providers only offered fiber to the home Internet service in select areas, generally just where the population was dense and all but ignored making high speed Internet available in most rural areas.

Taking a page out of Meeker's own history book, our Board of Directors thought if Meeker Cooperative Light and Power Association was able to bring electricity to our rural areas in 1935, why couldn't we bring high-speed Internet now? A decision was made that if we were going to connect our substations with fiber, we could build out an infrastructure that can serve our Members with broadband Internet.

Tribute to Karl Lundin


The board and employees of Meeker Cooperative are saddened by the death of District 9 Director Karl Lundin. We will remember Karl for his dedication and "can-do" attitude in everything he did.

Karl was best known as a carpenter, owning his own business, Lundin Construction. He built over 300 homes in the Litchfield area where he and his wife Darlene lived and raised five boys.

It may come as a surprise to many to learn that Karl helped oversee the construction of the Meeker Cooperative office and warehouse building when it was built in 2005.

Karl was elected as Meeker Cooperative's District 9 Director in 2003. Re-organization of the districts within Meeker's service territory left District 9 without a director and Karl won the election to fill the position. District 9 includes Forest City, Kingston, and North Kingston townships; however, directors serve all of the members.

In 2005, Karl was elected to serve as the Cooperative's Treasurer and moved up to be elected as Chair of Meeker Cooperative's Board in 2011. He served two 1-year terms as the Board Chair. He was again elected as an officer in 2018 and currently served as the Vice Chair.





In April 2008, Karl was appointed by the board to serve along-side the Cooperative's general manager as a STAR Energy Services Governor. Meeker Cooperative is one of the owners of STAR Energy which provides engineering, mapping and other support services to its member-owners and others.

While being a Director, Karl supported many items that have moved the Cooperative forward and impacted the Cooperative's growth. He provided expertise, as mentioned earlier, for the building of Meeker's headquarters, was involved in the implementation of the solar garden and supported the up-

graded metering installation. Karl was a huge proponent for VIBRANT Broadband, and was optimistic about Meeker helping its Members get connected with high-speed Internet.

On Board meeting days, Karl would often stop to talk to Meeker's employees on his way to the Board Room. He always looked out for the

> Members and kept your concerns in mind in every board decision he made.


We greatly appreciate Karl's commitment to the Cooperative and for being an example of the "Cooperative Way." He will be missed and we are thankful and honored to have known him.













PLAN FOR DUAL FUEL HEATING TO SAVE THIS WINTER

Meeker Cooperative's Dual Fuel Program can save you energy costs. If you plan now, you could be saving when winter arrives.

Dual fuel combines two heating sources to best fit your budget and meet your heating needs. With a dual fuel heating system, an electric heating source such as a high-efficient

air-source heat pump, is used in conjunction with fuel oil, natural gas, propane, or electric storage heat as the back-up system. The electric heating system is metered separately at 5.7 cents per kilowatt-hour (kWh) during May – September and 6.2 cents per kWh June – August. #36-36-202

Dual Fuel is a controlled electric heating program that helps save money and

conserve energy. When electric power demand is high, the


electric source is shut off or controlled. During this time, your home's back-up heating system provides the heat you need. During the summer months the cooling mode of the heat pump is cycled approximately 15 minutes on and 15 minutes off during a load control event.

Air source heat pumps which meet certain qualifications and requirements may be eligible for rebates ranging from \$530 - \$1,200. Call Meeker Cooperative's Energy Services experts at 320-693-3231 to find out more about this program and what options you have for Dual Fuel Heating.

Meeker Cooperative's bylaws specify that the Board of Directors may appoint a member to fill any open board seat. Once appointed, the Director will serve until the next Annual Meeting, at which time the seat will be up for election by the membership of the district to fill the unexpired term.

The application deadline is close of business (4:30 p.m.) on August 15. Selected applicants will be notified and will be interviewed in person by the Board of Directors on Monday, August 29.

After a lot of research and planning, construction of the fiber infrastructure began in 2018. In July of 2019 our first VIBRANT Broadband subscriber was connected. We now have thousands of satisfied subscribers happily surfing and streaming and staying connected with the World.

Tim Mergen is credited to coming up with the name VIBRANT for the broadband service. In 2015, he was at an Internet/ broadband conference learning about the industry and saw the word printed on a handout. He circled it thinking that it would be a great name for an Internet company.

Several years later, when Meeker Co-op decided the need to bring Internet to its Members was there and the Co-op was going to begin offering broadband service, he pulled out the paper with the word VIBRANT circled on it and the VI-BRANT Broadband brand was developed from there. #25-02-302

VIBRANT Broadband is one of only a few fiber-fed hybrid systems in the country bringing high-speed Internet to rural homes and businesses two ways; fiber-to-the-premises and fiber-fed fixed wireless.

This system allows VIBRANT Broadband to reach the most people in the shortest time-frame. It also allows VIBRANT to grow and expand quicker, reaching even more rural residents.



Rhubarb Slush

- · 8 cups rhubarb
- 2 cups sugar
- 1/2 cup lemon juice, added after cooking
- · 2 quarts water
- 1 small pkg, strawberry jello
- 1 cup vodka or brandy (optional)
- 7-Up
- 1. Simmer rhubarb, water, and sugar for 10-15 minutes. Drain and press through colander.
- 2. Add juice, jello, and vodka (or brandy). Stir until jello dissolves.
- 3. Freeze in ice cream pail at least 2 days before use.
- 4. To serve, scoop spoonfuls into glass and fill with 7-Up.
